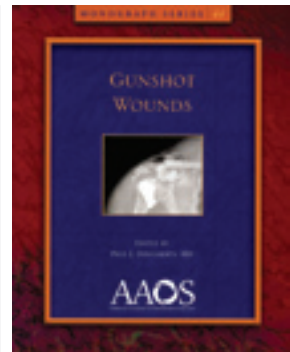
The Michigan Congenital Heart Center is the second-largest congenital heart program in the U.S., where pediatric specialists perform more than 850 cardiac operations each year.
